### HOW-TO:

#### THE HAIRSTYLIST BEHIND HEIDI KLUM'S FISHTAIL BRAID BREAKS IT DOWN

Hairstylist Rebekah Forecast says she wanted to add element of surprise to Heidi Klum's hair for an America's Got Talent season 10 red carpet event last week—and how she did it was with a sneaky fishtail braid. Here's how she says you can re-create it:

### STEPS:

1. "First smooth out the hair and create a silky texture by blow-drying with a Mason Pearson brush, Bumble and Bumble Prep Primer and Pravana Nevo Hydra Pearl Replenishing Hair Oil. It's important to start with the hair prepped to get the silky smooth texture throughout the style."
2. Directionally blow the hair off the face to incorporate any fine baby hairs in the front hair line.
3. Tie all the hair up in a ponytail just below the crown. "The position of the ponytail means the knot will not be seen from the front while accentuating the natural head shape," she explains.
4. Split the ponytail into three, adding some styling cream to smooth down any flyaways and create shine. (She used Phyto Creme Brilliance Glossing Cream.)
5. "To create a fishtail braid, start with two sections of hair (unlike a traditional braid when you start with three). Take a small amount of hair from the outside of each section and place it in the middle, creating three sections, which makes the braid hold. Carry this on throughout the hair length and secure with an invisible band. Tuck the end under and secure with a bobby pin."
6. Then twist the second section of the pony into a knot, secure, and repeat with the last section to form the desired size and position of the knot.
7. Spray with hairspray. Try: Kerastase Double Force.
